New Impetus: Oviston Outreach

Our ministry in Oviston was given a massive boost when we had a team from the Eastern Cape regional leadership of the Assemblies of God Association helping us with

door-to-door and open air outreach. As a direct result of that we now have close to 40 people

attending and participating in our Sunday gatherings. In addition to

that we have a growing Bible Study group on Tuesday evenings as well as a very well-attended community prayer action on Thursday evenings. It's remarkable that we regularly get between 15 and 20 *children* coming for Bible Study with the same number of adults.

New Impetus: Kingdom Impact Centre

The process to purchase the property to make our very first Kingdom Impact Centre a reality, is now in full swing. We envisage that the final transfer of ownership will be done before the end of June. And then the big work of renovating and refurbishing the building will begin.

A Not-So-New Challenge

Over the past 30 months a few things have become very clear:

- (1) The poverty level in the region is even worse than our initial observation in some places, like Oviston, unemployment is at a staggering 60%;
- (2) Any church planting and/or ministry effort in this region will be doomed to fail without at least initial financial support from outside;
- (3) We cannot do this on our own.

As stated in our previous newsletter, this situation poses an enormous challenge but, we believe, it is also a glorious opportunity for the light of the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ and the reality of God's heavenly kingdom reign to mightily impact lives and transform communities.
